1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common order.
2. The prayer made in the present petitions for quashing the impugned order dated 18.01.2002.
3. An additional affidavit was filed on 31.07.2019 for granting the benefits to the petitioner, which has not been rebutted by filing any replication thereto and reads thus:

“I, Guraditta Singh Sidhu, Chief Agriculture Officer, Bathinda, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as under :-

1. That Shri Buggar Singh Superintendent was promoted effect as superintendent with instead 18.06.2002 from 20.07.2004 respondent of on notional basis by the respondent vide this

office order No.4106-63/3A-10 (29)/E-3 (7) dated 31.03.2016.

2. That as per the above said orders the petitioner has allowed the ACP benefits on completion of 9 years service on notional basis with effect from 18.06.2011 and the revised pay of the petitioner has been fixed and the revised pension case has been sent to the Accountant General Punjab by Chief Agriculture Officer, Bathinda vide his letter No. 303 dated 12.01.2017.

3. That due to notional promotion the petitioner is not entitled for any arrear of pay, leave encashment, DCRG etc. upto the dated of 31.03.2016. The petitioner has been retired from this office with effect from 31.08.2012. Hence there is nothing any claim is pending with this office.

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present additional affidavit may kindly be accepted, in the interest of justice.”

4. Disposed of, reserving the petitioners with a liberty to approach the respondents, in case, any grievance still subsists.
