1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners has restricted his arguments and has submitted that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 31.01.2025 before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar raising their grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not been considered and no action has been taken thereon. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case appropriate direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation and take necessary action.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rubal Kanwar, AAG, Punjab, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful shall be done in due course.

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5. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to decide the aforesaid representation submitted by the petitioners within a period of one month from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say that if it is found that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they shall be provided adequate protection in order to protect their life and liberty.
