1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS 2023, (erstwhile Section 438 Cr.P.C.) in case FIR No.74 dated 27.06.2024 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC and under Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the State, upon instructions, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 02.04.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 02.04.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
