1. Both the learned counsels for the parties have submitted that these three cases are inter-connected.
2. CWP No.3294 of 2001 has been filed seeking a direction to respondent No.3 to get the election of the petitioner-Society conducted as per the election programme dated 10.02.2001 (Annexure P-1), CWP No. 6231 of 2000 has been filed for quashing of order dated 28.04.2000 (Annexure P-1), whereby an order was passed by the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ludhiana for removal of the Management Committee of the petitioner-Society and CWP No. 655 of 2000 has been filed seeking a direction to respondent No.3 to hand over the complete record of the petitioner-Society.
3. All the learned counsels for the parties have stated that the petitions are about 24 years old.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners stated that the counsel has not been able to retrieve the record of the present cases.
5. Considering the aforesaid prayer being made, it appears that with the efflux of time nothing would survive in the present cases since the matter pertains to an election held 24 years ago.
6. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, all the three petitions are dismissed.
7. Liberty is granted to the petitioners that in case any cause of action still survives, then an appropriate application may be filed for revival of the present petitions.
