Affidavit of Harkirat Kaur Channe, Director School Education (Elementary), Punjab dated 06.03.2025 has been filed on behalf of the appellant No.4 in compliance of the order dated 05.02.2025 which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to the counsel opposite.

The affidavit would depose that Rs. 1 lakh by way of cheque dated 01.03.2025 in favour of Gurbachan Singh has been handed to the counsel for the respondent who has countersigned the same as receipt. The order dated 05.02.2025 stands complied with.

Main case and CM-2296-C-2025

The instant application has been moved on behalf of the State Counsel for final disposal of the present appeal as the same has been rendered infructuous.



In light of the fact that in compliance to the order dated 03.05.1991, fresh appointment letter dated 12.11.1992 Annexure A-2 was issued in favour of the present respondent for the post of JBT Teacher. The respondent after attaining the age of superannuation retired from service on 31.03.2007 and all retiral benefits including GPF, GIS, DCRG were released in his favour in the year 2007 itself. A copy of such order is annexed as Annexure A-3.

Specific assertion has been made on behalf of the learned State Counsel to the effect that the respondent never raised any objection qua retiral benefits as well as pension and that fact has not been controverted by counsel for the respondent before this Court.

In light of the above, the application has merit, hence, the same is allowed and in light of the fact that retiral benefits stands released to the respondent, and there is no further claim on behalf of the respondent the present appeal has been rendered infructuous.

The present appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
