This is a petition filed Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) for directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the instance of private respondent No. 4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the local police, at the instance of respondent No. 4, is harassing the petitioners without any rhyme or reason and in this regard, the petitioners had moved a representation dated 13.02.2025 to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate

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directions are issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 13.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners.
7. Disposed of.
