1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents to immediately finalize the case of conferring of proprietary rights upon the petitioners and other persons of the village.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing the Deputy Commissioner, Fatehgarh Sahib to comply with letters already written to him by the competent authorities.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the matter.

3. In view of the above, instant civil writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
