The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* thereby directing the official respondent no. 1 & 2 for the protection of the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondents no.5 to 8 with a further prayer to for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to take action on the complaint dated 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-12).

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the complaint dated 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-12), within a time bound manner.

This Court without going into the merits of the case, dispose off

the petition at this stage itself.

The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the complaint dated 12.02.2025 (Annexure P-12) submitted by the petitioners after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, within a period of two weeks from today. However the complaint should be decided by an Officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioners within one week thereafter.
