1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 18.02.2025 (Annexure P-12) whereby the first Appellate Court while issuing notice of motion has not granted *ad interim injunction*.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at the time of issuing notice in the appeal on 07.02.2025, it was observed by the first Appellate Court that there are arguable points in the appeal and thus, notice was issued. It is further submitted that Civil Miscellaneous Application No. 8 of 2025 has been filed by the petitioner against the rejection of application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 and there is urgency in the matter and thus, has prayed that at this stage, the petitioner would restrict his prayer to an expeditious disposal of the said application No.8 of 2025 or in the alternate, the application (Annexure P-11) for *ad interim injunction* during the pendency of the appeal. It is further submitted that the main appeal is listed for 25.03.2025 and the respondent has already been served in the same and



has further submitted that the petitioner has filed an application for preponing the matter in which notice has been issued for 06.03.2025.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with the request to the first Appellate Court to decide the Civil Miscellaneous Application No.8 of 2025 or in the alternate, the application (Annexure P-11) for *ad interim injunction* during the pendency of the main appeal as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one week from 25.03.2025.

4. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
