JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to count his military service towards seniority, increments and pensionary benefits.

2. As per reply, the petitioner joined Indian Army in March' 1983 and worked till October' 1989. As per applicable Rules, military service is counted for seniority, increment and pensionary benefits if candidate had joined service during emergency, thus, claim of petitioner is not sustainable.

3. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioner has lost his interest to pursue the instant petition.

4. *Dismissed* with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
