The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, has been filed for quashing of FIR No.486 dated 29.12.2020 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC at P.S. Civil Lines, District Jind, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and Final report/Challan dated 05.11.2021 (Annexure P-8) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition at this stage, however, sought direction to learned trial Court to expedite the trial.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that out of 29 witnesses cited by the prosecution, only two remains to be examined and the same will be examined expeditiously.



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5. Be it the case, the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, however, considering the fact that the trial is going on, the learned trial Court is asked to make earnest efforts for expeditious disposal of the trial in accordance with law.
