1. In pursuance of the order dated 25.09.2025, Court notices were issued to the learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the petitioners. As per the office report, learned counsel for petitioners has since been elevated to the Bench. Notice issued to the petitioner No.2 has been received back unserved, with the report that he had died, whereas the third petitioner is stated to have gone abroad. The notice issued to the first respondent has not been received back, either served or otherwise.
2. The matter is pending since 2001. This Court has made efforts to inform the petitioners about the pendency of the instant case.
3. However, keeping in view the office report, this Court is left with no other option but to dismiss the instant petition for want of prosecution.
3. **Dismissed** for non-prosecution.
4. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioners to revive the instant petition by filing an apt motion in case the grievance survives.
