The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the third respondent to allow the petitioner to resume after allowing him rejoining his services as Attendant in view of the deployment letter dated 21.07.2022, Annexure P-8, issued by the fourth respondent and grant him salary as per revised wage rates.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 27.09.2024, Annexure P-12, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.



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4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 27.09.2024, will be decided by respondent no.2 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2/Director General of Health Services, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 27.09.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within eight weeks of receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
