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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 30.04.1993 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Collector, Faridkot and order dated 30.11.1998 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Commissioner, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur (in short 'Divisional Commissioner').

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-Gram Panchayat submits that this civil writ petition has been rendered infructuous as Gram Panchayat has already taken possession of the land in question.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner and pleads no instructions in the matter.

4. In view of the above, this writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
