Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* for releasing *detenue (R.), minor daughter of the petitioner*, from the illegal custody of respondent No.5.

2. This Court, on 24.02.2025, while issuing notice of motion, had passed the following order:-

Respondent No.4-Station House Officer, Police Station Chandi Mandir, District Panchkula, shall visit village Bharoli, Tehsil Barwala, District Panchkula, to get the detenue R., released forthwith, if found to be in illegal custody of respondent No.5, and an affidavit in this regard be filed on the next date of hearing. Copy of the same be communicated through learned State counsel.
