The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to produce the detenues, namely, Yuvin and Prayan who are the minor sons of the petitioner, before this Court.

Ms. Meenu Salwan, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5 to 8 and files her power of attorney in the Court today which is taken on record.

Report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar dated 01.03.2025 in terms of order dated 25.02.2025 passed by this Court has been received and the same is available on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner has been substantially redressed and the custody of the minor children has been handed over to the petitioner in compliance of the order dated 25.02.2025 passed by this Court. Further, the parties would be at

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liberty to settle the matter of custody of the detenues and pursue the appropriate remedy under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 (HMGA) or any other relevant statute in accordance with law.
