Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.133 dated 14.09.2015, registered under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 27 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners were falsely implicated in the present case. He submits that after investigation, cancellation report was also prepared in the present case, however, the same is never presented before the trial Court till date. He submits that the petitioners are facing agony of their false implication since the year 2015.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. On instructions from SI Ranjit Singh, at the outset, he submits that the concerned IO of this FIR had been declared proclaimed offender, who had the custody of the whole record. He further submits that necessary action has already been initiated and the record is being constructed. He prays for some time to enable the State to reconstruct the record and proceed with the necessary action.

In view of the submissions made above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State to reconstruct the record as submitted before this Court, expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today. The petitioners would be at liberty to pursue their remedy as available to them under law.
