1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common order.
2. Learned counsel submits that during pendency of the present petition, the pay of the petitioners has been protected, however, with regard to the arrears and interest thereon, they will submit a representation, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.
3. Disposed of accordingly. In case, petitioners submit representation/s within a period of 4 weeks, the same shall be decided within a further period of 6

months. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same may be passed after granting opportunity of hearing to them and shall contain reasons, whereupon they shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
