1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail in FIR No.132 dated 09.08.2024 registered under Sections 308(6), 204, 61(2), 238 of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
