The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.206, dated 02.12.2024, under Sections 333,115(2),118(1),324(2),303(2),191,190 of B.N.S,2023 and 351(2),304 of B.N.S added later on, Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sri Muktsar Sahib has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the

parties, the interim order dated 28.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
