Petition herein is for issuance of a Writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondent vide which plot No.201, Sector-39, Urban Estate, Gurugram has been shown to be cancelled and for issuance of a writ for directing respondent No.2 to issue fresh letter of intent or allotment prescribing the share of the petitioners instead of letter of intent dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P3) and provide time of 120 days to deposit the balance 75% of the bid amount and to restore the aforesaid plot.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the pending representation dated 26.12.2024 (Annexure P-11) is decided by respondent No.2 i.e. Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram, which has not been adverted to by the respondents, till date.

3. On the other hand, on advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion. He submits that grievance of the petitioner will be looked into by respondent No.2 and it shall take decision either way, on pending representation (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider pending representation (Annexure P-11) of the petitioners and pass an appropriate reasoned order, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy/ production of this order. If required, respondent No.2 i.e. Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Gurugram, shall give a personal hearing to the petitioners.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
