1. On 20.03.2023, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia relies upon Sections 3, 9 and 10 of the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019 to contend that by not provisioning for transgender person to apply, the rights of the petitioner who claims himself to be a transgender has been violated.

Notice of motion returnable for 17.07.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is allowed to participate in the selection process. He shall apply offline in the office of respondent No.3 who shall, on taking application form of the petitioner allow him to participate in the process provisionally.

Needless to say that such participation of the petitioner shall be subject to the final outcome of the writ petition and the same shall not vest any right in the petitioner.”

2. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab submits that pursuant to aforesaid order, the petitioner was permitted to participate in the selection

process, however, he could not be selected as he could not score cut off marks.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
4. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
