1. Through the instant petition, the prayer is made for issuance of directions upon respondent No.1-State Information Commission, Haryana to execute its order dated 16.11.2018 (Annexure P-8), vide which it was ordered that order dated 03.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1-State Information Commission, Haryana, be executed and report thereof, be called for.
2. No reply has been filed by the State.
3. This Court, at the outset, observes that how can the High Court become the Executing Authority of the said Commission, specifically, when they have enough power to get their orders implemented.
4. In light of this observation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty to approach the State Information Commission, Haryana once again for implementation of the order (supra).



5. Accordingly, the instant writ petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, and the matter is remitted back to respondent No.1 – State Information Commission, Haryana.
6. It is expected that the Commission will not raise the issue of delay or laches and will decide the application, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
7. Ordered accordingly.
