SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner is a foreign entity situated in Qatar and is importer of certain goods. It preferred a complaint dated 26.09.2023 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.3 against a firm, called M/s Striking International, situated in Ludhiana.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that the Committee constituted under Chapter 8 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2023 (Annexure P-2), which deals with such complaints, has not decided the said complaint dated 26.09.2023.

3. Ms. Divya Sharma, Advocate, who is appearing on behalf of the respondents, on advance copy, informs that notices have been issued twice to M/s Striking International, Ludhiana, against whom complaint has been made



by the petitioner, but to no avail. She also informs that it is not that the petitioner is without any remedy, as the Foreign Trade Policy, 2023 extends liberty to avail other appropriate remedies in law and, therefore, invocation of power of judicial review by the petitioner is uncalled for.

4. Without entering into merits of the matter and the petitioner having failed to avail other remedies available in law, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Committee on Quality Complaints and Trade Disputes (CQCTD) constituted under the Foreign Trade Policy, 2023, to decide the complaint dated 26.09.2023 preferred by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months.
