The prayer of the petitioner in this case was to direct the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, Haryana, the third respondent, to permit him to appear for the interview for the post of Auction Recorder.

It appears that pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, the petitioner was subjected to an interview. By order dated 1.10.2019, this Court directed the learned counsel appearing for the authorities to produce the result of the petitioner. Today, Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appearing for the third respondent, produced the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover. The same is taken on record for perusal and was thereafter returned to the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana. Perusal of the said result reflects that the petitioner secured 84 marks out of 200 marks in the written examination and 14 marks out of 25 marks in the viva voce /interview.

It is an admitted fact that the last selected candidate for the post of Auction Recorder secured 106 marks. As the petitioner secured far lesser marks, he does not come within the zone of consideration. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
