The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus seeking directions to produce the minor daughter of the petitioner i.e. Vamika Tomar @ Vinisha (aged 3½ years) before this Court who is stated to be in the illegal detention of respondents No.3 to 5.

2. None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

3. When this matter was taken up in the morning Session, Mr. Robin Singh Hooda, Advocate representing the petitioner, had appeared at that time and had stated that the petitioner only wanted to see his daughter through a Video Call.

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4. The learned counsel for the private respondent No.3 while placing on record the reply dated 25.07.2025 submits that the father has been shown the child who is admittedly in the custody of respondents No.3/Ankita who is the mother of the child.

5. In view of the aforementioned facts, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
