Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.22, dated 05.02.2025, under Sections 80(2) and 85 BNS, registered at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

2. As per facts of the case, Daler Singh gave his statement that his daughter Harjot Kaur was married to Maninder Singh alias Manu on 28.10.2024. After marriage Maninder Singh alias Manu went to America. During her stay in matrimonial home, his daughter was taunted and harassed for bringing less dowry. The husband of Harjot Kaur started ignoring her. He stopped picking up her phone. About 10 days ago, her daughter returned home in anger. On 05.02.2025 in the evening his son called him that his daughter Harjot Kaur @ Gori committed suicide by hanging herself with the ceiling fan in her room. She was taken to NHS Hospital, Kapurthala Road. There his wife disclosed that at about 4 o'clock



Harjot Kaur received a call and she was anxious. She came to her room while talking on phone. After sometime when his wife came down stairs, she noticed that their daughter had hanged herself. She was brought down and was taken to the hospital where she was declared dead.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners pointed out that petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased victim. They were granted interim bail vide order dated 28.02.2025 and they have already joined the investigation. Even, father of the deceased victim has given affidavit in their favour which is Annexure P-6.

4. Status report filed. The facts narrated in the FIR were confirmed. Learned counsel representing State on the instructions from ASI Yuvraj Singh No.2467 CP Jalandhar stated that petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for any other purpose.

Considering the aforesaid factual position, petitioners have already joined investigation. The complainant had furnished an affidavit in their favour which is Annexure P-6. Learned State counsel confirmed that petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for any other purpose. Therefore, interim bail already granted in favour of petitioners Kamlesh Kaur and Balvir Singh @ Balbir Singh vide order dated 28.02.2025 is confirmed subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS,2023.

- 5. Petition is accordingly allowed.
- 6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
