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Present application has been filed for early disposal of the main writ petition.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, learned Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the application is allowed and on the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main writ petition is taken up for hearing today itself.



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1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner on notional basis w.e.f. 08.07.2004 as SDO under old Rules, 1941 against the backlog post vacant for SC AMIE Degree Quota along with other service benefits.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the relief of grant of promotion to the post of SDO w.e.f. 08.07.2004 which is being claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition was granted to the similarly situated employees and the petitioner intends to approach the respondents for the redressal of his grievance by filing appropriate representation and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be considered and appropriate order on the said representation/claim will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of any such claim and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with



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liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

5. Ordered accordingly.
