1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that the application Annexure P-1 filed by the present petitioner under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C bearing CRM-615-2023 titled as Navjeet Singh Vs. Joga Singh is pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar, District SAS Nagar since 05.07.2023 and being unnecessarily adjourned from time to time, just for the purpose of awaiting the action taken report to be submitted by the concerned SHO. That no sincere efforts are ever made by the Court below to procure the said report of SHO, at the earliest. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to the Court concerned to decide the aforesaid application Annexure P-1, expeditiously without granting any unnecessary adjournments.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the SHO concerned will submit the concerned report in the near future after getting proper record from the office of



Tehsildar Kharar and in this regard letter dated 03.03.2025 is already written to the concerned quarter by the police authorities.

4. In light of the fact that the application Annexure P-1 is pending since 05.07.2023, without any further progress in the matter, the learned trial Court is hereby directed to dispose of the said application Annexure P-1 in accordance with law at the earliest, preferably within a period of 20 days of the receipt of action taken report which is to be submitted by the SHO concerned.

5. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to ensure and direct the SHO concerned to submit the action taken report before the Court concerned within a period of next 30 days of the receipt of this order.

6. The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.
