Present applications have been filed for seeking condonation of delay of 202 days in filing the application for restoration as well as for restoration of the main writ petition which was dismissed for non-prosecution vide order dated 19.07.2024 as well as for final disposal of the writ petition after its restoration.

For the reasons recorded, the applications are allowed. Delay of 202 days in filing the restoration application is condoned and the main writ petition is restored to its original number and status and the same is taken on board for final hearing today itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner was akin to one Chhota Singh along with other petitioners, who had filed CWP No.10125 of 2014 for regularising their services, which petition has been disposed of by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 05.12.2023 and a direction has been given to consider the claim of the petitioners therein.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the same footing, the respondents are liable to be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner as well.

3. Keeping in view the fact that nobody has appeared on behalf of the Punjab Agriculture, University, Ludhiana, the present petition is also disposed of in terms of the order passed in CWP No. 10125 of 2014 titled “***Chhota Singh and ors. Vs. Punjab State Agriculture University and anr.***”, decided on 05.12.2023.

4. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
