1. As common issues are involved in the captioned petitions, with the consent of both sides, the same are hereby disposed of by this common order. For the sake of brevity and convenience, facts are borrowed from *CWP-18047-2004*.
2. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 16.09.2004 whereby his name was removed from List-CII (Exemptee).

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from his client, however, he may be granted liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.
4. The petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application within three months, if cause survives
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
