The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.44, dated 27.09.2024, under Sections 13(1) r/w Section 13(2) of P.C Act as amended by PC Act 2012 r/w Sections 409,465,466,467,471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.05.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
