NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 04.05.2001, whereby the current duty charge assigned to the petitioner has been withdrawn and to quash the proceedings of the D.P.C. held on 10.04.2001 vis a vis the petitioner. Further, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and promote the petitioner to the post of Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies on regular basis w.e.f. the date he was granted current duty charge i.e. 23.12.1999 with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed as having not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
