1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondent to allow them to work and release their wages from 18.05.1999.

2. The petitioners were transferred from Municipal Council, Karnal to Municipal Council, Panipat.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta submits that initially Municipal Council, Panipat did not permit them to join but later on petitioners were permitted to either join at Panipat or at Karnal. No employee was retrenched. Few of the petitioners have superannuated and few have already passed away. They were paid salary and nothing is outstanding against the respondent.
