By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS,
2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as
under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance
to the order dated 18.03.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 18.03.2025, following order
had been passed: -

“ S.I. Pawan Kumar, Investigating Officer of the case is
present in Court today.



2. *Status report dated 17.03.2025 in the form of an affidavit of Additional Superintendent of Police, Hisar has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.*

3. *Heard.*

4. *On perusal of the record and submissions made by both the sides, it transpires that the petitioner was not named in the FIR nor she was having any criminal antecedents but has been nominated on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused from whom 6.13 grams of heroin was recovered.*

5. *Admittedly, apart from the aforesaid disclosure statement, there is nothing substantive on record against the petitioner.*

6. *Be it the case, without commenting on the merits, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within 07 days from today and in the event of her arrest, she is ordered to be released on interim bail on her furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.*

7. *List on 03.04.2025.*

8. *Investigating Officer of the case to remain present in Court along with record on that date.”*

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from S.I. Pawan Kumar informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 18.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 18.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
