1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.67, dated 24.01.2025, under Sections 406 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Azad Nagar Hisar, District Hisar (Annexure P-1).
