Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to re-issue passport to the petitioner, which was applied by him on 16.01.2025 (Annexure P-4).

2. Ms. Sehaj Sandhawalia, Advocate, appears in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been served upon the respondents-Union of India. She submits that in case the petitioner appears before the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar on 16.04.2025 at 11:00 A.M. and submits the last passport held by the petitioner and/or the other

documents which may be required for processing the application for re-issuance of passport to the petitioner, the necessary decision as regards the issuance of passport to the petitioner shall be taken by the concerned Authority within a period of six weeks from the date such documents/information are supplied by the petitioner.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
