The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner(s) seeking issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to offer compassionate appointment to petitioner No.1 in terms of the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019 and also to grant compassionate financial assistance from the date of death of their mother till offer of appointment to petitioner No.1.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioner(s) would be satisfied in case respondent No.3-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, is directed to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

The present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.3-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana to consider the case of the petitioners by treating the present writ petition as a representation and the same shall be decided expeditiously and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, after granting an effective opportunity of hearing to the respective parties, in accordance with law.
