1. Present petition has been filed praying for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner from the hands of local police, i.e. respondents No.3 and 4.
2. Precise submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner is facing prosecution in FIR No.151, dated 09.07.2012, under Sections 21/29-61-85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and there is no other case pending against him, however, respondent No.4 is harassing him without any rhyme and reason.
3. Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr.Tarun Aggarwal, Sr.DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.
5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the facts of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to proceed

with the inquiry/investigation, if any is pending against the petitioner expeditiously, strictly in accordance with law.
