JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 21.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) whereby he has been transferred from Account Branch to general duty.

2. The petitioner claims that he is suffering from spine disease, thus, it is difficult for him to perform general duty. Ignoring his medical condition, the respondent has transferred him from Account Branch to general duty. On the earlier occasion, his matter was considered but by impugned order, he has been transferred.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that competent authority would reconsider petitioner's claim. His claim would be considered in the light of his medical condition.

4. In the wake of statement of State counsel, instant petition stands disposed of. Let the petitioner's claim be sympathetically reconsidered.
