SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 05.08.2024 passed in ARB-539-2023, which is reproduced as under:-

“1. Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that in 2013, the applicant had paid a sum of 10 lacs to the respondent. The respondent is not disputing its liability.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent, during the course of hearing, submits that respondent is ready to refund the aforesaid amount along with interest as determined by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner also leaves the question of interest for adjudication by this Court

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondent to refund the aforesaid amount along with interest @ 7.5% per annum within two months from today.”



- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that order dated 05.08.2024 passed in ARB-539-2023 has now been complied with.
- 3. In view of the above, contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
