The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 27.04.2001 (Annexure P-12/T) and 14.05.2001 (Annexure P-13/T) passed by respondent No.3 vide which the pay of the petitioner has been reduced from Rs.6400-10640 to Rs.5800-9200 without issuance of any show cause notice.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has already retired from service and got all the necessary benefits, therefore, he does not wish to press the present petition.
