1. The petitioners No.1, 2, 4 and 5 have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.17 dated 22.01.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 191(3), 190, 118 of BNS (Section 118(2) of BNS Act, 2023 added later on), at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 11.03.2025 is made absolute.
