There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. On the last date also, he remained unrepresented.

2. The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the remaining retiral benefits to the petitioner, i.e., leave encashment with interest on the delayed payment. Directions have also been sought to revise the petitioner's pension with effect from the date of his retirement, and release the arrears. It has been claimed that he got promotion as District Primary Education Officer two days prior to retirement.

3. Learned State counsel contends that the petition is bereft of necessary particulars about the claim raised. It is not forthcoming as to when

the pension payment order was issued to the petitioner, nor has any order of

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promotion to the post of District Primary Education Officer been placed on record. Despite efforts, the Department has not been able to find out any document regarding the petitioner's pay, etc.

4. In the absence of necessary averments bringing all relevant facts on record, duly substantiated by valid documents, the claim cannot be considered.

5. Dismissed.
