1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 04.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram whereby the petitioner was directed to meet the minor child on 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every English Calender month in the Court premises from 10.00 Am to 11.00 AM.

2. The respondent was directed to bring the minor child as per the above schedule for visitation of minor child with the petitioner.

3. Mr. Shubham Aggarwal, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent and files his Power of Attorney. The same is taken on record.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent points out that vide order dated 13.08.2025 in the Transfer Petition (Civil) No. 3132-3133-2024 titled as Nishant Anand Vs. Shivika Gandhi and others “ In the meantime, all proceedings *inter se* parties shall remain stayed.” has been directed. A copy of the order dated 13.08.2025 has been handed over in Court and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same stands **disposed of** as having been rendered infructuous.
6. Rule stands discharged.
7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
