NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari/mandamus, for quashing order dated 13.03.2000 passed by respondent No.2 and for directing the respondents to promote him as Tehsildar with effect from 24.11.1982 and thereafter to promote to Punjab Civil Services (Executive Branch) with effect from 20.12.1985 i.e. the date when his junior was promoted.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
5. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
