Present second petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.0007 dated 11.01.2022, under Section 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind.
