By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
87	26.07.2024	333, 304, 351 (2), 115 (2), 190, 191 (3), 329, 62 of BNS, 2023	Khilchian, District Amritsar Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the orders dated 19.03.2025 and 21.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide orders dated 19.03.2025 and 21.04.2025.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



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4. During the course of hearing on 19.03.2025, following order was passed:

“ Heard.

After hearing the submissions and perusing the record, admittedly, no injury is attributed to the petitioner.

Be it the case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

List on 21.04.2025. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the orders dated 19.03.2025 and 21.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide orders dated 19.03.2025 and 21.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

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7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
