The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 528 of BNSS for quashing the case FIR No. 30 dated 18.02.2025 under Sections 143, 318(4), 61(2) of BNS and under Section 24 of Emigration Act registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga. The basis for seeking this relief is the compromise deed dated 25.02.2025 (Annexure P-2), whereby they claim to have settled their differences with complainant/respondent No.2.

2. Ms. Ramandeep Kaur, Advocate appears and filed her Vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant and confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondent No. 2 has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. She

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has produced original affidavit of the complainant in support of compromise and compromise deed in the Court today and the same are taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioners and they have no known criminal antecedents.

4. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

5. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 30 dated 18.02.2025 under Sections 143, 318(4), 61(2) of BNS and under Section 24 of Emigration Act registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom shall stand quashed.
