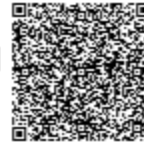
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**SANJAY VASHISTH, J.**

1. Petitioner, Jadeep Singh, has filed the present (fourth) petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking regular bail in connection with FIR No. 403 dated 25.05.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, and 302 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), with Section 325 IPC added subsequently at Police Station City Sonipat.
2. It is alleged that the petitioner inflicted serious injuries on Jaikaran Rana and Santosh (since deceased).

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Rahul Dev, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, City Sonipat alongwith custody certificate dated 29.07.2025 in Court today. Same are taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place with the paper-book.

Learned State counsel has informed the Court that out of total 34 prosecution witnesses, 32 have already been examined.

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3. Considering that this is the fourth bail petition and keeping in view the advanced stage of the trial, this Court does not find any substantial ground to entertain the bail application at this stage. Accordingly, same is dismissed. However, the learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and make every effort to conclude the proceedings within a period of three months from the date of this order.
